The capabilities of the handler are to be assessed, NOT the animal being led. The qualifier will then be eligible for the final at the Royal Highland Show in June 2014.

CLYDESDALE HORSE SOCIETY YOUNG HANDLERS MERIT ROSETTES are awarded to those who have taken part but do not qualify FOR THE Royal Highland Show. (Class 146)  
ENGRAVED PLAQUE presented by Miss Ann Pickering to the winner of the Young Handlers Class.  
The ISLE OF MAN HEAVY HORSE SOCIETY has donated £10 towards the prize money in Class 146.  
The ANN PICKERING SILVER CUP (Cup 254) plus an additional prize of £10 to be awarded to the winner of the Heavy Horse Riding Class 147 presented by Miss Ann Pickering  
The ERNEST GRIFFIN SILVER CUP (No. 29) by Mr Ernest Griffin for the Best Exhibit in Class 148  
SHIRE HORSE SOCIETY - SILVER SPOON and ROSETTE for the Best Shire Stallion and for the Best Shire Mare or Filly awarded by the Shire Horse Society. Winners must be members of the Shire Horse Society (subject to the SHS special conditions of offer).  
CLYDESDALE HORSE SOCIETY SHIELD - Shield (supplied and engraved by the Clydesdale Horse Society) to be awarded to the best yearling or two year old colt or filly, registered or eligible for registration in the Society Stud Book, not having won a shield before in its lifetime. The Exhibitor must be a current member of the Clydesdale Horse Society.
