1. Entry fees for all showjumping classes £5 per horse per class.
2. British Showjumping members please be aware that in the event of there being fewer than 4 starters in any affiliated competition, the organisers will request the competitors agreement to RULE 75.13 (Classes 162, 164, 166, 167, 172, 174, 176 and 178)
3. British Showjumping members: In the event of the competitors not being in agreement, the organisers reserve the right to invoke RULE 76.14
4. British Showjumping members: Competitors are advised to take note of RULE 76.6 which has recently been amended.
5. British Showjumping members: Entrants in Showjumping Classes MUST state on their Entry Forms the name of the horse and Pony, also the Rider and Owner along with their respective CURRENT British Showjumping Membership and Registration Numbers.
6. All riders when mounted must wear hard hats marked PAS015 or prefixed with ASTM or SE1 with strap properly adjusted and fastened. Hats may be inspected: you will not be allowed to continue if your hat does not meet these specifications.
7. Unaccompanied Competitors must provide the Show Organiser with a contact telephone number in case of an emergency.
8. British Showjumping RULE 82.19: NO Member shall allow a Stallion for which he/she is responsible as owner, lessee, authorised agent or rider to compete or be prepared to compete, in any jumping competition without taking adequate precautions to ensure other members of the public are not put at risk of injury.
