and then the top FOUR in each class will be presented  
in the main ring for final judging at 7:30pm.

## YOUNG HANDLER CLASSES

Cattle must be exhibited in breed classes, but need not be owned by the Handler. Please state Handler's date of birth on the entry form.

Handlers under 18 years of age on the day of the Show must be supervised by an adult. The safety of the public must also be taken into consideration.

- YHC** Under 14 years of age on day of Show, size of animal should be appropriate for age of handler.
- YHJ** 14-18 years of age on day of Show, size of animal should be appropriate for age of handler.
- YHI** 19-21 years of age on day of Show, size of animal should be appropriate for age of handler.
- YHS** 22-26 years of age on day of Show, size of animal should be appropriate for age of handler.

## SHEEP SECTION

- Class 23 2 LAMBS Ewe or Wether. Recognised Pure Hill Breeds only. (up to 45 kg)
- Class 24 2 LAMBS Ewe, Beltex or Texel (up to 45 kg)
- Class 25 2 LAMBS Wether, Beltex or Texel (up to 45 kg)
- Class 26 2 LAMBS Ewe, Mule Cross to Terminal Sire (up to 45 kg)
- Class 27 2 LAMBS Wether, Mule Cross to Terminal Sire (up to 45 kg)

Note to Exhibitors: Sheep will be kept in the lairage at IOM Meats until Wednesday morning. They will be provided with water, cake and hay.

## **PIG SECTION**

Pigs will be judged in the lairage at IOM Meats before slaughter on the morning of Tuesday 27<sup>th</sup> November. Sorry, no spectators allowed.

### **NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS**

# **RULES**

1. **ALL animals (except pigs) entered in the Christmas Prime Stock Show must be exhibited at Knockaloe Mart on Monday 26<sup>th</sup> November.**
2. Exhibitors may enter a maximum of FOUR entries per class in the Unaltered Classes.
3. Sheep will be transported to the lairage at IOM Meats following the live show and kept for slaughter on Wednesday morning. Hay, cake and water will be provided.
4. Pigs will be judged in the lairage at IOM Meats on Tuesday morning.
5. The British Beef Company's Silver Challenge Trophy will be awarded to the exhibitor with the most points awarded from Classes 5 to 11 (live haltered classes) and 32 to 35 (carcase classes)
6. Unaltered exhibits (Classes 1, 2 & 3) will not be eligible for the Best Exhibit awards at the Live Show
7. The Champion Carcase will be judged from the winners of Classes 31 to 35
8. Animals will be judged as the "Best Butcher's Beast".
9. Animals must have been kept on the Island for at least six months prior to the date of the Show.
10. Each animal may only be entered in one class (Extra Classes excepted)
11. Exhibitors must ensure that before sending animals to the show they are properly marked for identification purposes.
12. Exhibitors must place their animals at the disposal of the Society's Show Director for the Young Farmers Stock Judging Competition.
13. Cattle and Sheep must be penned by 5:30pm. The Mart will be open from 12 o'clock for the arrival of livestock.



14. Judging will commence at 6:00pm for Sheep; 7pm for Unaltered Cattle in the cattle pens and 7.30pm for Cattle (haltered and unaltered) in the main ring.
15. Animals must be accompanied by their passport.
16. Viewing of the Carcase Competition commences at 6:00pm followed by the Prize Presentation at 7:30pm.
17. **Closing date for Entries will be Saturday 10<sup>th</sup> November 2018.** Due to the need for IOM Meats to know definite intake numbers for their processing plans, late entries will NOT be accepted.
18. **Entries for all animals and carcasses must be made through the Society Secretary. There will be no entries accepted on the day of either Show.**
